Effective Winter 2014 session, the following sections of the catalog have been amended/added:

Amended to page 23:

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY

Applicants whose first language is other than English must meet one of the English proficiency requirements listed below:

- Present an appropriate TOEFL score (500/173/61 for undergraduate, 525/197/71 for graduate, and 550/213/79 for Ph.D.) plus the TWE (Test of Written English) and TSE (Test of Spoken English) exam results. The TOEFL is administered by the Educational Testing Service (ETS). The Trident University ETS registration number is 4775.
- Present documentation for the equivalent of two years of study (secondary level and above) in a program where English is the medium of instruction.

UNIVERSITY GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor Level Programs

1. **Total Credits:** A minimum of 120 semester credit hours must be earned by every undergraduate student to be eligible to graduate from Trident University International. Some programs may require more units – See table below.
2. **Residency:** Student must complete a minimum of 32 semester credit hours at Trident University International.
3. **Upper Division Course Requirement:** All undergraduate students must complete a minimum of 36 semester credit hours of coursework at the 300 and 400 levels.
4. **General Education Program:** All undergraduate students must complete the General Education Program requirements as stated in the catalog.
5. **Academic Program:** All undergraduate students must also satisfy all requirements of the individual program.



Master Level Programs

1. Total Credits: A minimum of 36 semester credit hours must be earned by all Master-level students to be eligible to graduate from Trident University International. Some programs may require more units – See table below.
2. Residency: Student must complete a minimum of 28 graduate-level semester credit hours at Trident University International. Some programs may require more units – See table below.
3. Academic Program: All Master-level students must also satisfy all requirements of the individual program.

Doctoral Level Programs

1. Total Credits: Total Degree Credit Hour Requirement includes 56 semester credit hours of required coursework.
2. Residency: Student must complete a minimum of 52 semester credit hours (40 of coursework and 12 dissertation) at the Doctoral-level at Trident University International.
3. Academic Program: All Ph.D. students must also satisfy all requirements of the individual program.
4. Qualifying Exam: All Ph.D. students must pass their qualifying exam.
5. Dissertation: All Trident Ph.D. students must conduct their research (i.e., collect data, analyze it, report the findings and provide a full discussion of them), write the full five chapter dissertation and successfully defend the dissertation proposal and completed dissertation within a maximum number of 12 sessions.
