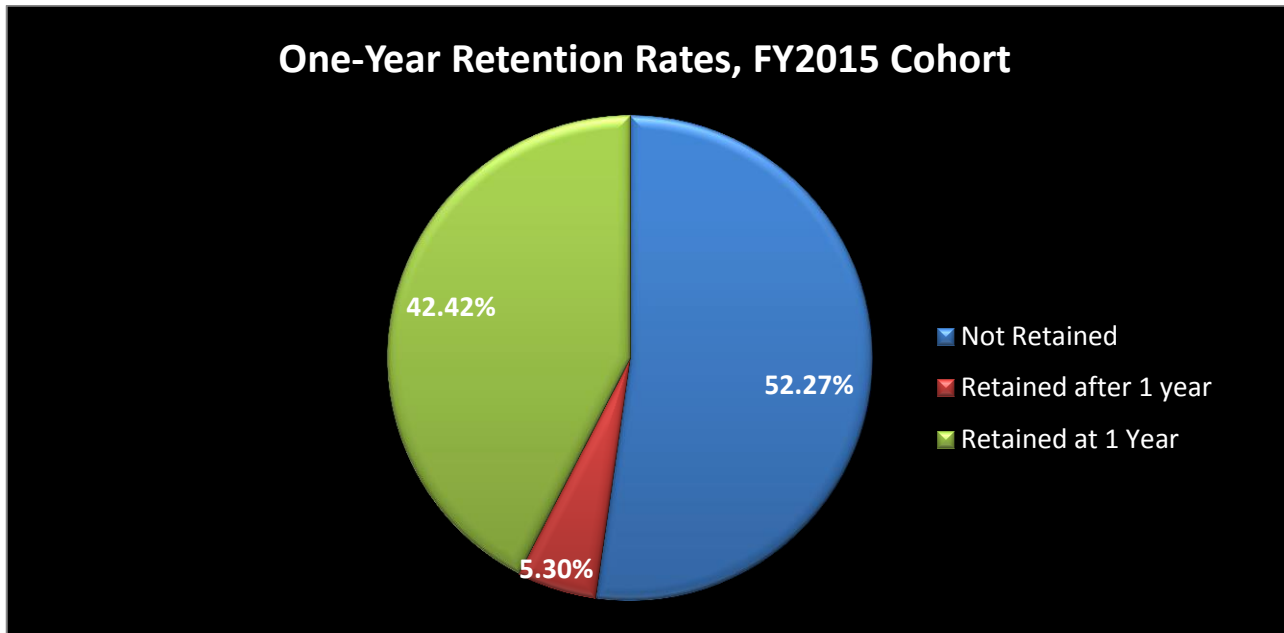

**Definitions**

**Retention rate** – Percent of entering cohort who enrolled one year later (within 3 month) or successfully completed their program. For example, students starting in January 2015 would be considered retained if they were enrolled in a term which started in either January, February, or March 2016.

**Entering Cohort** – Students who started a Doctoral degree program for the first time at Trident University

**2015 Fiscal Year** – From Summer 2014 through June 2015 Fastrac terms
